Job Description

TITLE: Clinical Coordinator/Instructor, Emergency Medical Services

SUMMARY: The Clinical Coordinator/ Instructor will be responsible for classroom, laboratory and clinical instruction in emergency medical services at the Associate's Degree level at any of the GSCC campus sites (day or night) and related activities for program development, revision, and implementation.

REQUIRED MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Associate's Degree in Emergency Medical Services.
- Current State of Alabama Paramedic License.
- Three (3) years of successful full-time field experience as a paramedic.
- Emergency Medical Services teaching experience in the classroom and clinical.
- Yearly documentation of required continuing education activities as required by ADPH.
- AHA instructor certifications in BLS, ACLS, and PALS.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Excellent customer service skills.
- Excellent problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work independently.
- Competency in the use of computers and software used to support instruction.
- Commitment to an inclusive, student-centric teaching and learning process supported by the philosophy of Gadsden State Community College and the Alabama Community College System.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelor's Degree in Emergency Medical Services or related field.
- Three (3) years of Emergency Medical Services teaching experience.
- NAEMSE Level I Instructor Certification
- ITLS Instructor Certification
- EVOC Instructor Certification

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Instruct didactic classes, conduct laboratory classes, and supervise clinical sessions in Emergency Medical Services.
- Conduct instruction in a wide variety of settings and time frames including: day, evening, and weekends both on and off campus. Some travel may be required.
