

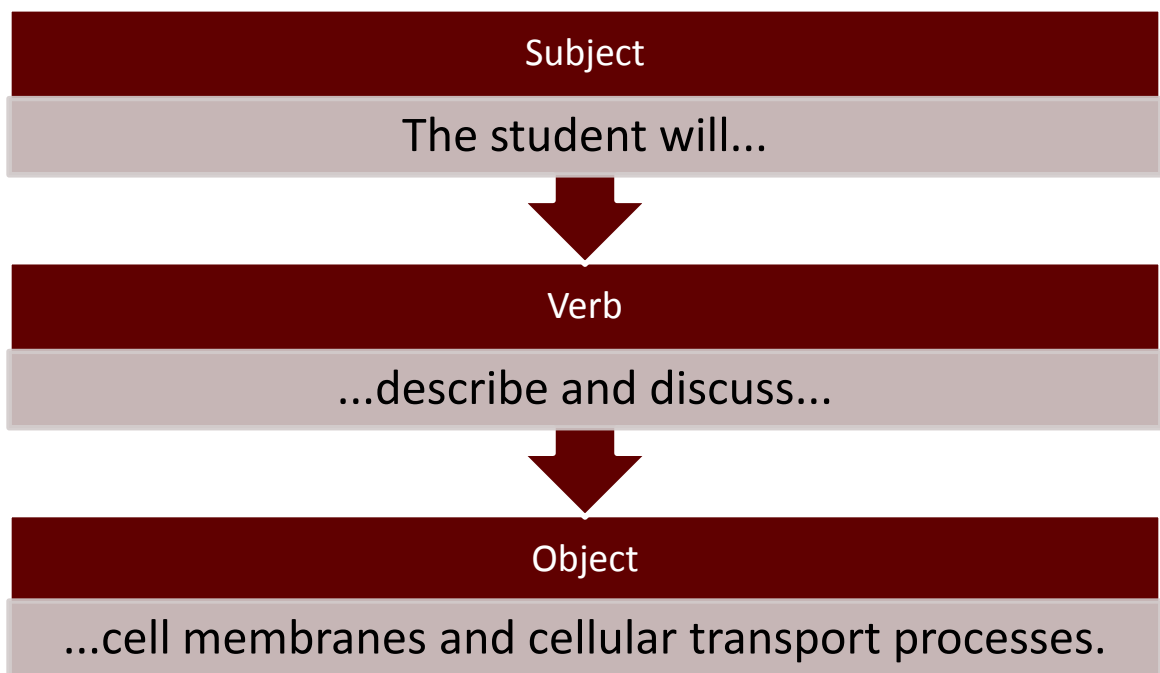
Writing Student Learning Outcomes

Format: Subject – Verb – Object

Subject: The subject is always the learner, never the instructor (The *student* will...,)

Object: This is the skill or knowledge the student should obtain as a result of completing the program

Verb: Always an “Action Verb” (define, describe, discuss, demonstrate, compare, differentiate, judge, construct, create, design, develop, etc), see page 16 of *A Faculty and Staff Guide to Creating Learning Outcomes*.¹
